
The April 3, 2018 special meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Julie Lyon. Council members present were Cheryl Blanton, Ryan Clark, Dennis Dye, Andy Holmes and Nicholas Minks. City staff present was City Administrator Downing and Police Chief Osburn. There were two guests present.

City Administrator Downing informed the Council that they did not put the close date or remodeling deadline in the motion at the previous Council meeting accepting the Recreation Commissions proposal for the annex. Council member Holmes made a motion to approve a close date of April 12, 2018 for the annex property and to select two years for the remodeling term in the contract; Council member Clark seconded the motion. Motion carried 5 – 0. Council discussed various codes and worked to prioritize codes that were the most concerning around town. There was much discussion regarding large animals, mowing and dilapidated structures. It was the consensus of the Council to continue working on code enforcement and further review the large animal and poultry ordinance to consider additional restrictions.

With no further business before the Council, Council Member Clark made a motion to adjourn at 8:18; Council member Minks seconded the motion. Motion carried 5 - 0.
