There was discussion regarding the best way to handle that as all codes would then need to give notifications before enforcing. Council member Blanton asked City Administrator Downing to thank the City crew for all that they have been doing cleaning up the trees and alleys in town. Mayor Lyon informed the Council that she attended a league training recently and there was a lot of discussion on policy re-enforcement and she also added that there were positive comments on the work being done around town as well.
